Sub: Conclusion rate agreement for the supply of items, mentioned in the enclosed schedule required for the use of Dr. RML Hospital, New Delhi.

It is proposed to enter into a rate agreement between your firm herein after referred to as contractor and the Medical Superintendent, Dr. RML Hospital for and on behalf of the President of India, herein after referred to as purchaser for the supply of items listed in the enclosed schedule.

1. The agreement shall be valid for one year from the date of opening of tender.
2. The period required for supply must be specifically indicated for each items. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or perform the services within the time period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages a sum equivalent to **0.5** percent of the deliver price of the delayed goods or unperformed services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, up to a maximum deduction of **10** (ten) percent of the delayed goods or services contract price. Once the maximum is reached the purchaser may consider termination of the contract. However, Medical Superintendent has the discretion to extend the delivery period without penalty if satisfied by the reasons of delay.
3. It will be the condition that the prices charged for the items supplied to the hospital shall in no event exceed the lowest, at which the contractor sells the same to any other person/institution. If any time during the contract period the contractor reduce the sale price entered into the rate agreement, he will notify such reduction to the Medical Superintendent.
4. **Rates should be quoted on F.O.R. (Dr. R.M.L. Hospital) basis.**
5. No figures or words should be overwritten. In-correct words/figures should be scored off and re-written under your initials.
6. **Tax and duties , where legally livable should be distinctly shown along with price quoted, in case it is not done, no claim regarding Tax and duties etc. will be entertained in future.** In case there is a revision in the existing rate of tax/duty by the Government, the same will be paid subject to production of satisfactory documentary proof.
7. **Quotations should be as per Sl.No. of the enclosed schedule and other terms & conditions as specified therein .**
8. All the damages in transit detected at the time of supply shall be at the risk & cost of the contractor.

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9. All supplies rejected shall be removed by the supplier immediately. If the supplied items are not collected within the stipulated period it will be disposed off in any manner deemed fit by the purchaser.
10. The Medical Superintendent, Dr. R.M.L. Hospital reserves the right at his discretion to accept or reject any tender at any stage in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
11. All items received shall be subject to inspection on receipt of the stores & the purchaser shall have full discretion to accept or reject, either the entire supply or any part thereof and his decision in this regard shall be final & binding on the supplier. **This form together with the schedule shall be deposited in the tender box lying near Reception Counter, Old Building in the envelop duly sealed, page Number should be marked on each page of bid.**
12. **The offer's of Govt. Outlet/Govt. approved agencies will only be considered.**
13. **All Successful Bidders are required to submit Performance Security in the shape of Bank Guarantee of Rs. 50,000/-. It should remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of contract.**
14. Outstation bidders should ensure that their quotations must be **deposited in the tender box lying near Reception Counter, Old Building** before opening of bid.

Special Terms & Conditions that has to be adhered by the suppliers are as follows :

- 1 Supply of goods should be made in the kitchen & Canteen premises.
- 2 Supply will have to be given on credit basis.
- 3 Goods supplied should be of good quality.
- 4 The decision of the I/c Kitchen and Canteen about the quality would be final and binding on the supplier.
- 5 The replacement of substandard goods should be made on the same day.
- 6 In case of non-supply of indented goods or failure to replace substandard goods. Medical Superintendent has the right to cancel their contract without assigning any reason.
- 7 A notice period of at least one month has to be given before discontinuation of supply.
- 8 No security shall be given on crates/containers and cartage shall be borne by the supplier.
- 9 No advance shall be paid for the supplies.
- 10 No mediator/middleman should be involved in transactions i.e. from supply to payment in case any such mediator is detected, the firm shall be blacklisted for a period of 2 years.
- 11 To submit performance certificate of satisfactory supply of fruits & vegetables to Govt. institutions for a minimum of 3 years.
- 12 To submit a certificate to the fact that no chemical is used for pending of fruits & to make vegetables look fresh.
