Subject: - Filling up 60 posts in various sub-cadres of Central Health Service on deputation/Short Term Contract basis- regarding.

Madam/Sir,

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has decided to invite application to fill up 60 posts in various sub-cadres of Central Health Service namely General Duty Medical Officers (GDMO), Teaching Sub-cadre, Non-Teaching Sub-cadre and Public Health Sub-cadre for appointment purely on deputation basis from amongst the officers holding analogous posts under Central Government (including Ministries of Railways and Defence) or State Governments or Union Territories and by Short Term Contract from suitable officers holding analogous posts under the statutory bodies, autonomous bodies, semi-government organization, Universities or recognized Research institutions under Central/State Governments.

2. Officers holding analogous posts on regular basis, having requisite qualification and experience and having completed their period of probation in the parent organization can apply for appointment on deputation to CHS indicating the name of the post and sub cadre, through proper channel. The details of post, Pay Matrix of posts, qualification and experience required for the posts in the respective Sub-cadre of CHS are indicated in the respective annexure as below:

3. The appointment on deputation basis will be made only on availability of vacancies and fulfilment of the educational and other eligibility criteria. The officers selected will have All India Transfer Liability and will be posted at a place where vacancies exist at the time of their selection. However, the candidates applying for a particular post may submit (THREE) preferences for their place of posting.

4. The officers selected for appointment on deputation to CHS may elect to draw

either the Pay in the Level prescribed in the Pay Matrix of deputation post or his/her basic pay in the parent cadre plus Deputation (duty) Allowance thereon plus personal pay, if any. The period of deputation will be governed by CHS Rules, 2014 as amended from time to time. However, the Ministry can end the term of deputation unilaterally if the regular recruitment takes place or if the policy gets changed due to any reason(s). The terms of deputation will be governed by standard terms of deputation as prescribed by the Government of India from time to time.

5. Application in the prescribed proforma (Appendix-A) along with the other requisite documents mentioned at Para 6 below may be forwarded to **The Under Secretary (CHS-V/VI), U-8/ Work hall no. 11108, First Floor, C-Wing, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Kartavya Bhawan-I, New Delhi** within forty-five days of the date of publication of the INDICATIVE ADVERTISEMENT IN THE EMPLOYMENT NEWS. All applications should reach this Ministry through proper channel. **Advance copy of the application will not be entertained.**

6. While forwarding the application, the following documents duly attested by parent department may be sent to this Ministry along with the application in the prescribed proforma: -

- i. A certificate to the effect that State Government/Union Territory or the Parent Department/Organization has **NO OBJECTION** to the appointment of the officer concerned under CHS on deputation.
- ii. Reckonable APAR of the last five years. In case, the APAR is not initiated/available, a certificate in lieu of the APAR needs to be issued with appropriate reasons and APAR for the preceding year may be made available. (each and every page duly attested.)
- iii. Cadre Clearance/ Vigilance Clearance Certificate / Integrity Certificate / Statement of Major/minor penalties imposed during the last 10 years in the prescribed format. (Appendix-B)
- iv. Educational qualification certificate, as applicable.
- v. Valid Medical Council Registration Certificate.
- vi. The detail of regular post held by the officer along with copies of the offer of appointment in the parent department, probation completion certificate, all promotion orders and pay last drawn by the officer in the parent department.
- vii. At least 3 (THREE) preferences for place of posting. (Appendix-C)

Incomplete application(s) or applications received without above-mentioned documents are liable to be summarily rejected.
